
Rooms for hire

Pershore's Riverside Centre has a small, dedicated team of staff, regular volunteers and 12 trustees. Abi, our Centre Manager manages room bookings, finance and everything else that keeps us working effectively. Brad, our Lead Youth Worker is qualified with a BA in Youth & Community. Brad is supported in the sessions by Terri our lead SEND youth worker, and a team of trained youth workers. All staff, youth workers and visiting healthcare professionals are DBS checked and work within safeguarding protocols. Everyone involved in the youth work is aware of the issues faced by some of Pershore's young people and is passionate about engaging with, supporting and motivating them to find a way through any concerns – while having fun and eating pasta!
